

RESULTS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS!

2023 was another good year for Ohio Gamma. We have a wonderful group on the AVC Leadership team guiding and mentoring the undergrads. We meet monthly to compare notes and discuss objectives. We are also pleased to have a District Governor, Sean Willins, who is very involved. Last year our National Headquarters revised that position and reduced the number of chapters they are responsible for. The District Governors are now responsible for assisting the AVC rather than a focus on the undergrads. So we now have a high level of support from Sean which is much appreciated.

Spring recruitment is now the primary recruitment period at OSU. Freshmen cannot join any fraternity prior to spring semester. Our undergrad chapter added 18 new members this spring and 14 in the fall of upperclassmen. Our current membership stands at 86. We also reached a new milestone this year with 26 men signed up to live in the chapter house next year. That means a full house with single rooms and the undergrads are now looking at ways to utilize the larger rooms as doubles as we have at least 5 more men who would like to live in the house. It's great to see the men so interested in living in the chapter house!

From a GPA perspective, fall semester was 3.41 for the chapter. While most of us would kill for a 3.41 GPA, we ranked in a tie for 7th amongst the 28 fraternities at OSU. Interestingly last spring we ranked 4th with a 3.4. To give some further perspective, take a look at the chart at the right. We were not as high in the rankings as we would like but happy to still be performing significantly better than the "all student" and "all Greek men averages". It's also clear how much the women outdo the men when it comes to GPA!



If you are wondering how Greek life is going at OSU, it is growing. Last year there were 28 Fraternities and 40 Sororities. This year 3 new Greek organizations either started or returned to campus so we have a total of 71. The latest available individual member count was 5,287 in the Autumn of 2023. That was up from 4,593 in Spring of 2023. So a nice 15% bump!

DONATIONS URGENTLY NEEDED!

In the section below, we have recapped our donations over the past 4 years. The highest number of donors was 2020 when 119 brothers made a donation. That declined over the next 2 years and had a nice uptick in 2023. However, we have over 1,200 living alumni!

You can also see 10 brothers are carrying a significant portion of the load with donations over \$5,000 in a single year. And only one brother on that list is younger than age 73!

As a fundraiser, I often think about where we would be if even half of our alumni gave \$100 a year!

Our fraternity is functioning now at a high level. We have a professional property manager, an accounting firm, and a firm to manage our database and communications.

FUNDRAISING ACTIVITY AND HISTORICAL RESULTS

We thought you might be interested in a historical recap of donations over the past 4 years. Since 2020, 163 alumni have made a contribution.

These are all services our National Headquarters recommends for a high performing fraternity.

We really function like a University now in that we set a rate for rent based on what we need, but we have to be cognizant of the fact that the rate we need is not necessarily competitive with what the men would pay in other housing arrangements. So we provide scholarships to make up the difference. The scholarship need for the school year starting August, 2024 is about \$70,000 or \$35,000 per semester. Right now we only have about \$17,000 in our scholarship funds, so we are dangerously low and will need at least another \$18,000 between now and August.

Of course the bottom line is that donations are on a declining slope and we really need your help to keep the chapter house functioning at a high level. If you are donating regularly please keep doing so! If you can make your donation soon rather than year-end that would also help. You can donate on our website: ohiogamma.org/donate.

UNDERGRAD ACTIVITY

While our undergrads have many types of activities going on, we wanted to highlight those that are helping the community:

COMPOSITE DIGITIZING PROGRAM

With a chapter that is 115 years old, you can imagine there would be no way to hang all the composites (group photos of brothers) on the walls of the chapter house. From that perspective it's probably good we are missing a lot of them!

Realistically storage of composites is a problem and most alumni never get a chance to look at them unless they come to the chapter house. Thankfully Jared Forts, a brother from Valparaiso, is actively involved with our Ohio Gamma chapter mentoring our VP Communications. He also happens to have his own studio in the business of graphics and photography. So we started a program to digitize all the composites we can find. For the one's not hanging on a wall at the house, we remove them from the frames and photograph them under special lighting to "digitize" them. Then we keep just the composite itself and dispose of the frame which really reduces storage issues.

Digitizing all the composites and putting them on our website in the future will also make the composites available to all who might want to check out a name or picture of a long lost brother, or just remember what we looked like in college! Interestingly, we have never seen a composite prior to 1962 and it seems probable now that composites were not done prior to 1962. We are also missing most of the composites from 1967 through 1993. Since 1962, we can account for 46 composites of the 61 years.

Of course there may well have been years when no composite was made, but if anyone has a small copy of a composite around we would really like to get it so we can digitize it, then send it back to you. So if you have one, let me know at waggonj55@gmail.com.


